

"I Will Order All Things for your good"


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- 1. <u>Scripture Hop</u> Follow instructions on page 3 below for a scripture hop for D&C 112:10. Talk about what it means to be humble. One part of being humble means we're willing to listen to the Lord and do what He asks us to do. What things might He ask/did He teach us to do during conference?
- 2. <u>Being Humble</u> If we're humble, we do things like pray to Heavenly Father and follow the things He wants us to do, such as things we were taught in conference. When we are humble, He is able to help us more in our lives. Read/discuss/summarize "<u>Humility</u>" in *True to the Faith*. Sing "<u>Be Thou Humble</u>."
- 3. <u>Blindfold Activity</u> (from the manual) Put a blindfold on one of the children, and ask him or her to walk across the room with another child leading him or her by the hand. Tell about an experience when you felt the Lord leading you by the hand.
- 4. The Things of God Can Be a Treasure to Me From the manual: These verses (<u>Doctrine and Covenants 111:2, 9–11</u>) could encourage a discussion about what your family values as eternal "treasures." You could create a treasure hunt by hiding things around the house that represent things the Lord treasures or values. As your family finds each item, discuss what you can do to show that you value it.
 - To help us review conference, we're going to use favorite quotes from conference to represent the treasures. If you have older kids, you could have them come up with their own favorite quotes from conference and write them on the treasure pieces on pages 4-5 below.
 - Since our kids are so young, we'll have some quotes already written up for them to review. Hide them and take turns finding them. As they're found, discuss each.
 - After talking about each, display them on a poster board or in the treasure box printout from the manual.
 - <u>During Conference</u>: If you want to do this during conference instead of after, you can print up the
 treasure pieces and have them write/draw things they learn during the talks. Our kids decided to try to
 have a "drawing station" area during conference this year, so I'm thinking we'll print up the treasure box
 and treasure pieces as an option in the drawing station for them to do while they're listening to talks.
 Theredcrystal also has some <u>fun conference coloring pages</u> that we'll probably have in our drawing
 station as well.
- 5. The Lord Treasures Me! (The Lord will Lead Me By the Hand and Answer My Prayers) Mom/Dad share reasons why we love ("treasure") each kid. Does the Lord love ("treasure") each of you too? (Yes!). D&C 111:11 says that the Lord wants to "order all things for your good." Talk about what this means and let each kid color "The Lord Treasures Me!" sheet from page 7 below.
- 6. <u>Coin Treats</u> Eat coin treats while reviewing how valuable we are to the Lord and how valuable His words should be to us.


SCRIPTURE HOP

Cut apart the following strips and spread them out far enough in a room so that the kids will need to hop from one strip to another. Make sure to keep them in the correct order. Have them stand by the first one and help them say the top line out loud. Explain what it means. Then have them jump to the next one and do the same thing until they've jumped on each of them, said them out loud, and discussed them one at a time. Then have them start back at the beginning and practice saying the phrases from this verse in order while hopping from strip to strip again. Try going a little faster each time. Repeat as many times as wanted/needed. These can also be used as flash cards, taped onto the wall to practice throughout the week, etc.


One each treasure piece, write down a quote from conference that is valuable to you.




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The Lord Treasures Me!
