


"Rebel Not ye Against the Lord. Neither Fear"

- 1. <u>Video</u> Watch and discuss "<u>Moses and the Brass Serpent</u>" video from the church or this "<u>Moses and the Brass Serpent</u>" video from Latter Day Kids.
- 2. <u>Fiery Serpent Game</u> Show picture on page 3 below and summarize the story found in Numbers 21:6-9. People were dying from fiery serpents that bit them. Moses made a brass serpent and put it on a pole. If anyone was bitten, what did they have to do to be saved? (Look at the brass serpent on the pole). Read John 3:14-15 and talk about how Jesus Christ is like the brass serpent. Show <u>this picture from the manual</u> to help them visualize how this brass serpent was similar to Jesus on the cross. When our spirits get hurt by Satan, how can the Savior heal us?
 - Print up the board game on page 4 below. Each person find a small object to use as their game piece. Roll a die to determine how many spaces to move forward.
 - If someone lands on a "SNAKE BITE!" space, they will automatically be out of the game unless they state something they can do to look to the Savior in their lives. Print up the picture on page 5 below and tape it up on the wall. Have each person write down the ways they'll look to the Savior on this page.
- 3. <u>Modern-Day Fiery Serpents</u> Read/discuss/summarize this "<u>Modern-Day Fiery Serpents</u>" article from the church's website. Discuss things that might exist in our lives that could be like "fiery serpents." What are some things that could hurt our spirits? Talk about how Christ can help us with these things.
- 4. <u>Song and Testimonies</u> Watch/listen to/sing "<u>Jesus the Very Thought of Thee</u>" and testify of the importance of looking to Him each day.
- 5. Scripture Draw Do the scripture draw on page 2 below.
- 6. <u>Brass Serpent Treat</u> Use edible gold spray from <u>Walmart</u> or <u>Hobby Lobby</u> to make your own brass serpent. You could do this by molding Rice Krispies treats or sugar cookies like the snake on the pole and then spraying them with the gold color (or whatever other creative idea you have).

Read and summarize Helaman 8:15.




Summarize the story of the brass serpent in your own words.
